<i>Hyla andersonii</i>	Pine Barrens Treefrog	2; tolerant of highly acidic waters (Hulse et al. 2001)
<i>Hyla chrysoscelis</i>	Cope's Gray Treefrog	3
<i>Hyla cinerea</i>	Green Treefrog	2
<i>Hyla femoralis</i>	Pine Woods Treefrog	3
<i>Hyla gratiosa</i>	Barking Treefrog	2
<i>Hyla squirella</i>	Squirrel Treefrog	2
<i>Hyla versicolor</i>	Gray Treefrog	2
<i>Pseudacris brachyphona</i>	Mountain Chorus Frog	2
<i>Pseudacris brimleyi</i>	Brimley's Chorus Frog	1
<i>Pseudacris c. crucifer</i>	Northern Spring Peeper	3
<i>Pseudacris feriarum</i>	Upland Chorus Frog	3, variety of temporary and permanent waters (Hulse et al. 2001)
<i>Pseudacris feriarum kalmi</i>	New Jersey Chorus Frog	3, variety of temporary and permanent waters (Hulse et al. 2001)
<i>Pseudacris ocularis</i>	Little Grass Frog	2
<i>Pseudacris triseriata</i>	Western Chorus Frog	3, variety of temporary and permanent waters (Hulse et al. 2001)
Pelobatidae	Spadefoot Toads	
<i>Scaphiopus holbrookii</i>	Eastern Spadefoot	1
Ranidae	True Frogs	
<i>Rana catesbeiana</i>	American Bullfrog	3, but do require permanent water [for overwintering adults/larvae] (Hulse et al. 2001)
<i>Rana clamitans melanota</i>	Northern Green Frog	3, habitat generalist (Hulse et al. 2001)
<i>Rana palustris</i>	Pickere! Frog	3
<i>Rana pipiens</i>	Northern Leopard Frog	2
<i>Rana septentrionalis</i>	Mink Frog	2, only permanent waters (DeGraaf and Rudis 1983)
<i>Rana sphenoccephala</i>	Southern Leopard Frog	2
<i>Rana sylvatica</i>	Wood Frog	2
<i>Rana virgatipes</i>	Carpenter Frog	2
Microhylidae	Narrow-mouthed Frogs	
<i>Gastrophryne carolinensis</i>	Eastern Narrow-mouthed Toad	2
