<i>Tantilla coronata</i>	Southeastern Crowned Snake	Mar-Oct, but primarily May-Aug (Ernst and Barbour 1989; Mitchell 1994)
<i>Thamnophis brachystoma</i>	Short-headed Garter Snake	Mar-Nov (Hulse et al. 2001)
<i>Thamnophis s. sauritus</i>	Common Ribbon Snake	Mar-Oct, but active on warm days in winter (Mitchell 1994)
<i>Thamnophis sauritis septentrionalis</i>	Northern Ribbon Snake	Mar-Oct, but active on warm days in winter (Mitchell 1994)
<i>Thamnophis sirtalis pallidulus</i>	Maritime Garter Snake	Mar-Nov, but yr round if warm in
<i>Thamnophis s. sirtalis</i>	Eastern Garter Snake	Mar-Nov, but yr round if warm in winter (Mitchell 1994)
